Astra Security (www.getastra.com) was engaged by Loom to perform a Vulnerability Assessment & Penetration Testing (VAPT) on the following assets of Loom -

- Loom Web App
- Loom Screen and Cam Recorder iOS Application
- Loom Screen and Cam Recorder Android Application
- Loom Chrome extension
- Loom Desktop app (Windows & macOS)

The objectives of the engagement were to identify exploitable vulnerabilities, subvert standard workflows, gain un-authorized access to the application or user records, and attempt an underlying compromise. The assessment was conducted using a grey-box methodology. Testing was performed by Astra's security engineers on test environments between 7th September 2023 to 12th October 2023.

Upon completion of the testing, Astra provided Loom a detailed report of vulnerability findings and recommendations. After these fixes were in place, Astra conducted a re-test to ensure the vulnerabilities have been remediated effectively & subsequently issued a certificate of Pentest completion.
