The Missing Link was engaged by Atlassian to perform a code-assisted web application penetration test of the Compass web application. Compass is a cloud-based developer experience platform that allows customers to unify distributed software architectures and the teams working on them. Compass offers a component catalogue to provide visibility into software components and their ownership, health scorecards to track the health of components and teams, and extensibility with the Atlassian Forge platform to customise the experience.

The objectives of the engagement were to identify exploitable vulnerabilities, subvert standard workflows, gain unauthorised access to the application, sensitive information, or user generated content, and attempt an underlying server compromise.

Automated and manual penetration testing was performed by two security consultants between the 12th of June and the 1st of July 2024 in the cloud staging environment. During testing, the consultants had access to relevant repositories, development guides, and engineers to ask questions of.
